- 2 CHRIS: We will. Thank you. Really, thanks so much. And I'm
- 3 sorry for —
- 4 DIRTY MAN: Don't mention it. Really, don't mention it. Bye.
- 5 (He leaves.)
- 6 TAYLOR: Well, we completely misjudged those two men,
- 7 didn't we?
- 8 CHRIS: Yeah, and all because of what they looked like. Who
- 9 would have thought?
- 10 TAYLOR: I guess that shows that you really can't judge
- people by how they look. Are we going to make our show
- 12 on time?
- 13 CHRIS: Oh, yeah, but we'd better hurry. I can't wait to see
- 14 Julie Quinn.
- 15 TAYLOR: Oh? Have you seen her act before?
- 16 CHRIS: No, but she's gorgeous. If she was a dinosaur, she'd
- 17 be a babe-a-saurus.
- 18 TAYLOR: So much for your lesson on judging books by their
- 19 cover.
- 20 CHRIS: Oh, was this play a book first?
- 21 TAYLOR: Let's go. I think you need to get out of the sun.

8. The Project

Topic: Group of students trying to get motivated to put together a project

Cast:

COURTNEY: a go-getter, trying to work correctly and up against lazy classmates

BEN: would rather be anywhere but here; he's lazy, sarcastic, and bored

ILAN: the class brainiac and extremely well-spoken

KIM: nice, fun-loving, and loves to eat

- (ALL sitting around in various positions. COURTNEY has
- paper and pencil, trying to take notes. BEN is trying to sleep.
- ILAN is sitting upright, hyper-focused. KIM is playing with her
- 4 hair, her mind obviously elsewhere.)
- COURTNEY: (Obviously been working at this for a while) If we don't start on this, we're never gonna finish.
- BEN: (Tossing a ball in the air and catching it) I hate these
- stupid projects. Why do we have to do this stuff anyway?
- 10 ILAN: (Softly, but assuredly and clearly) To enhance our
- learning and increase our appreciation for the world
- 12 around us.
- 13 KIM: You sound like a walking encyclopedia, Ilan.
- 14 ILAN: Well, I think it's an interesting and engaging opportunity.
- 16 BEN: Of course you do. You're like a miniature teacher.
- 17 COURTNEY: (Clapping hands) People! People! No bickering!
- We're gonna have to start if we ever want to finish.
- 19 KIM: (Shifts weight, looks at her nails.) Isn't it time to take a break? I think I need a snack.
- 21 COURTNEY: We just started! No breaks. Let's at least get

- 1 ILAN: I think we should explore all the possible
- 2 manifestations of precipitation in order to determine the
- 3 appropriate methodology of commencing our project.
- 4 BEN: Is he even speaking English?
- 5 KIM: No English I ever heard.
- 6 COURTNEY: I think he said we should think about the
- 7 different kinds of rain in order to figure out how to start.
- 8 BEN: Why didn't he just say that?
- 9 ILAN: I did.
- 10 BEN: (Sits up.) No, this is what you said: "Blah blah blah.
- 11 Blah blah blah blah blah project."
- 12 COURTNEY: You're not helping matters, Ben. We have to
- 13 get started.
- 14 KIM: (Whining) I'm hungry.
- 15 BEN: (To ILAN and KIM) Ryan had a huge brownie for lunch
- 16 today. He wouldn't share, but it looked really good.
- 17 KIM: Did it have chocolate chips?
- 18 BEN: I think so. But no nuts. I hate nuts.
- 19 KIM: Me, too. My mom puts nuts in her cookies every
- 20 Christmas and I won't eat them.
- 21 ILAN: Oftentimes an underlying allergic sensitivity to nuts
- 22 and legumes of all types causes gastrointestinal upset
- 23 and is mistaken for disliking when it may actually
- 24 represent an allergy.
- 25 BEN and KIM: (Pause, then say together) Huh?
- 26 COURTNEY: (Exasperated. Throws pencil in the air and drops
- 27 notebook.) I give up! I'm writing this for our paper,
- 28 Sometimes it rains. Sometimes it snows. Sometimes it's
- 29 foggy. The end. How's that?
- 30 BEN: I love it.
- 31 KIM: Me, too. You hand that in, Courtney. Come on, Ben,
- 32 let's hit the vending machines. (BEN and KIM leave.
- 33 There's a pause.)
- 34 COURTNEY: I was kidding.
- 35 ILAN: (Pause) Do you oftentimes sense that you are alone in

- the universe without an understanding soul existing on
- 2 this whole planet?
- 3 **COURTNEY**: (Looks at him like he's crazy.) All the time.
