1	(JON and JEN: It is important for these characters to be
2	played as good friends. There should be no hint of any kind
3	of romantic or "sexual tension" stuff between them. They
4	are, above all, compatriots. The scene takes place at JEN's
5	home.)
6	JON: Jen, are you here?
7	JEN: I'm in the bathroom, just a second.
8	JON: Take your time. I don't have anywhere to go.
9	JEN: I thought you had a date.
10	JON: Nah. Didn't work out.
11	JEN: How come?
12	JON: We just didn't, I don't knowsync.
13	JEN: (Entering in robe, drying hair) Sync?
14	JON: Sync. You know, blend, meld, form as one, come together.
15	JEN: Oh. Sync.
16	JON: (Picking up apple) You gonna eat this?
17	JEN: No.
18	JON: (Taking a bite) Yum. Tart.
19	JEN: Yeah?
20	JON: Yeah. Tart, but not too tart. (Taking another bite) Kind of
21	sweet, too.
22	JEN: So, it's a good apple?
23	JON: As apples go, yes, I would say that this is a good apple. A
24	very good apple. This is a top-of-the-line apple.
25	JEN: Good. (She begins combing out her hair.)
26	JON: You've got great hair.
27	JEN: But would you call it top-of-the-line hair?
28	JON: Hmmm. Top-of-the-line hair, you say? Let me see. Yes, I
29	would definitely call this hair top-of-the-line hair. Thick.
30	Black, almost pitch in color. (He sniffs her hair.) Fragrant.
31	Yes, top-of-the-line hair. Top-of-the-line apple, top-of-the-
32	line hair.

JON: A good day. Not a top-of-the-line day, but a good day all

IEN: Having a good day, are you?

in all.

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IEN: So, what happened to your date? ION: Didn't work out. We didn't... JEN: Sync... JON: Sync...yes. IEN: What does that mean, exactly? JON: Well, OK. OK. For example, she's a blower. JEN: A blower? I think I've heard enough. JON: Don't be lewd. No, she's a blower. She blows a lot. Like my ear, my neck, she even blew on my eyes. IEN: Some people might find that sexy. ION: Not if they wear contact lenses. JEN: I see the problem. OK, she blew on you. That's not so 12 bad. She can be retrained. 13 JON: No...she's too far gone. - 3 Chuckles. I mean, she was a sincere laugher.
- 4 JEN: That's a good thing. I can see why you felt good.
- 5 JON: Oh, there's more. While we were at the movies...
- 6 JEN: What did you see?
- 7 JON: Pulp Fiction.
- 8 JEN: Again? Not a great date movie.
- 9 JON: It was a test. If she could like that movie, she was a girl I
- 10 could like.
- 11 IEN: And did she?
- 12 JON: That was the amazing thing. She loved it.
- 13 JEN: Well, there you go.
- 14 JON: I know. Who would have thought? So, anyway, there we
- were, watching the movie and holding hands...
- 16 JEN: On the first date. That's so intimate...
- 17 JON: That's what I thought. But she seemed to want to, and
- who am I to argue...?
- 19 JEN: Hand holding...
- 20 JON: I know, but that's how it was going...
- 21 JEN: The holding of hands...
- 22 JON: So, then, there we were, for the longest time.
- 23 JEN: Holding...
- 24 JON: Yes. And you know how your hand gets sweaty...
- 25 IEN: I hate that.
- 26 JON: But there's nothing you can do about it...
- 27 JEN: You are so right...
- 28 JON: Except to just release and wipe.
- 29 JEN: Yeah. I know, yes. Release and wipe. It has to be done...
- 30 JON: But, if you do it right, it's a sly move.
- 31 JEN: You think?
- 32 JON: Oh yeah, very smooth. You do the release and wipe, and
- then, instead of going back to the everyday hand hold,
- what you do is put your hand on top of hers, see? My
- hand goes on top and then our fingers entwine.

- 13 JEN: Then why did you start it?
- 14 JON: It looked good.
- 15 JEN: Huh, jeez, I hate when you do that. Just toss it in the
- 16 trash.
- 17 JON: You won't get ants?
- 18 JEN: I don't know. It's too cold for ants.
- 19 JON: I'll just hold it.
- 20 JEN: You're going to save it for later?
- 21 JON: Maybe.
- 22 JEN: Won't it turn brown?
- 23 JON: Not if I put lemon on it. Do you have any lemon?
- 24 JEN: I'll check. So, go on. How did it get better?
- 25 JON: On the drive home.
- 26 JEN: I hate that. I hate the drive home on a first date. Don't
- 27 you hate that?
- 28 JON: You don't even know. Torture.
- 29 JEN: It's worse for the woman. You are wondering if he will or
- won't, and if he doesn't is it because your breath is bad,
- and if you do, will he think you're easy. So many things to
- think about. Your entire future is tied up in just those
- few moments in the car on the way home from a movie.
- 34 JON: No, for the guy, you are wondering if you're going to get
- 35 turned down or what.

- 1 JEN: Stop. Girls don't turn guys down for a goodnight kiss.
- 2 Have you ever been?
- 3 JON: Let me think. No, I don't think I have.
- 4 JEN: We just don't. Even guys we have no intention of seeing
- again we will at least toss them the P.K.
- 6 JON: P.K.?
- 7 JEN: Pity Kiss. I'll bet you've been P.K.'d and not even known
- 8 it.
- 9 ION: You think?
- 10 JEN: Oh, yeah. We do it all the time. Better to P.K. and get out
- of the situation fast than to make excuses for hours on
- end. I'm telling you, it's usually a P.K. and run.
- 13 JON: P.K. I'll have to remember that. P.K. OK, we're driving
- home, and here comes the real test. The Chapstick Lip
- 15 Balm test.
- 16 JEN: No! You didn't.
- 17 JON: Not me...her!

 - the air and then blowing immediately after) ...like that.

- 29 JON: Isn't it? Let me show you. (He leans over, blowkisses her
- 30 cheek.)

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- 31 JEN: Ewww. That is not sexy.
- 32 JON: I didn't think so, but hey, I'm for new things. So, there
- 33 she is blowkissing my face and my neck.
- 34 JEN: You found this exciting?
- 35 JON: I wouldn't say I found it exciting, no. I couldn't

1	concentrate. I started counting.
2	JEN: Counting what?
3	JON: The blowkisses. She got up to twenty-six before I finally
4	thought, OK, let's see what she does on the lips.
5	JEN: She blewkissed your face twenty-six times?
6	JON: I counted. I know for a fact it was twenty-six times.
7	JEN: And no lip contact yet?
8	JON: Nope. So I thought, kiss the girl and see what happens.

15	mouth, not for this boy.
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
