39. Scary Teacher

Topic: Students dare to approach a teacher.

Cast:

JILLIAN: kind of bossy, a little afraid of the teacher

JULIA: timid, willing to work out a plan CASSIE: logical and straightforward

- (Scene opens with the GIRLS Center Stage in a horseshoe
 configuration playing rock, paper, scissors.)
- 3 JILLIAN: OK, go. Rock, paper, scissors! (They all choose rock.)
- JULIA: Let's do it again. Rock, paper, scissors! (They all choose paper.)
- 7 CASSIE: We could be here all day doing this.
- 8 JILLIAN: It would be easier if one of us just volunteered to
- 10 CASSIE: (Grabbing this idea) Thanks, Jillian, that would be
- 11 great. Go ahead.
- 12 JILLIAN: (Sarcastically) Yeah, right. Let's go again. Rock,
- 13 paper —
- 14 JULIA: This is stupid. We should all go together.
- 15 CASSIE: I don't want to. You two can go.
- 16 JILLIAN: I don't want to. You two can go.
- 17 JULIA: (Trying to be reasonable) Come on, guys. I'll go if you
- both come with me. (They pause.)
- 19 JILLIAN: No, I still don't want to go. She hates me. She'll
- 20 yell at me.
- 21 JULIA: She does not hate you.
- 22 CASSIE: Yeah, I think she's right. She does hate Jillian.
- 23 JULIA: (Frustrated) Oh, for goodness sake!
- 24 JILLIAN: She never picks me for messenger and last week
- when I was late she made me take that math test.

- 1 JULIA: We all took the math test.
- 2 JILLIAN: Yeah, but she put it on my desk real mean-like.
- 3 CASSIE: (Trying to bring them back on task) We're not really
- 4 getting anywhere with this. Why don't we just write a
- 5 note and leave it on her desk?
- 6 JULIA: That never works. Remember when she said adults
- 7 admire kids who speak up?
- 8 JILLIAN: Yeah, they always say that, until you actually do
- 9 speak up.
- 10 JULIA: We're just gonna have to ask her. Together. In
- 11 person.
- 12 CASSIE: Julia's right. She's just a human being, after all.
- What can she do to us?
- 14 JILLIAN: Are you kidding? She's a teacher. She can do
- anything she wants to us!
- 16 JULIA: Not true. She's not that bad. We just have to be
- 17 respectful-like. Let's practice.
- 18 JILLIAN: (Suddenly excited) Oh, let me be her, please?
- 19 CASSIE: Oh, OK.
- 20 JILLIAN: (Gets snooty, acting like a grown-up.) Yes, girls, is
- there something you need?
- 22 JULIA: Uh, Miss Tambor, we'd like to speak to you a
- 23 minute.
- 24 JILLIAN: Fine, but make it quick. I'm late for my karate
- 25 lesson.
- 26 CASSIE: Jillian!
- 27 JILLIAN: Oh, OK. (Changes back to modified grown-up.) Yes,
- 28 girls, what is it?
- 29 CASSIE: Miss Tambor, we'd like to ask if you would
- 30 consider allowing us to have a bake sale.
- 31 JILLIAN: A bake sale? For what purpose?
- 32 JULIA: To raise money for our trip to New York.
- 33 JILLIAN: (Short pause, pretending to consider) All right. That
- would be fine. (They pause.)
- 35 CASSIE: Well, that was kinda easy.

- 1 JULIA: Do you think it will be that easy with her?
- 2 JILLIAN: Only one way to find out. Let's go.
- 3 CASSIE: Hey, Jillian. Remember, you're not an adult
- 4 anymore.
- 5 JILLIAN: Right. I'll behave.
- 6 JULIA: Sure. I believe that. (They exit.)

40. Permanent Probation

Topic: A goofy driver is pulled over by an overworked police officer.

Cast:

OFFICER: trying to keep things going smoothly, very professional DALE: completely clueless, should be nowhere near a moving vehicle

- (Scene can be set with DALE sitting in a chair pretending to
- 2 hold a steering wheel, facing forward. OFFICER approaches
- 3 from behind.)
- 4 OFFICER: Can I see your license and registration, please?
- 5 DALE: Why, officer? Was I speeding?
- 6 OFFICER: License and registration, please.
- 7 DALE: (Slight hesitation) Well, there might be a slight
- 8 problem with that.
- 9 OFFICER: (Steps back, speaks emphatically) Step out of the
- 10 car, please.
- 11 DALE: OK, OK.
- 12 OFFICER: What's the problem with the license and
- 13 registration?
- 14 DALE: Don't have it.
- 15 OFFICER: You mean you left your identification at home?
- 16 DALE: No, I mean I don't have it.
- 17 OFFICER: You don't have a license?
- 18 DALE: Do I look sixteen to you?
- 19 OFFICER: Exactly how old are you?
- 20 DALE: Can I go to jail for lying to a policeman?
- 21 OFFICER: Whose car is this?
- 22 DALE: My dad's.
- 23 OFFICER: Does he know you're driving without a license?
- 24 DALE: Of course not. Don't be silly. It was my mom's idea.
- 25 OFFICER: Do you have your learner's?
- 26 DALE: Don't you have to be like fifteen or something to get
- 27 that?
