- only silence as RICHARD simply looks at REPORTER and

down at your shoes.

RICHARD: Yes, they're dirty. I stepped in some mud coming in. (A beat) Did you know there's ten different types of soil within a fifty-mile radius of this place?

REPORTER: No. Really? I didn't know that. Is that true?
