CAST: (2M, 2F) BILLY, WES, AMY, RENE PROPS: Books, dictionary.
SETTING: A school library.

- 1 (At rise BILLY, WES, AMY and RENE are at a table reading.)
 2 BILLY: (Glances up and looks down.) No, no ... you have to be
 3 quiet.
 4 WES: Who? Me?
 5 AMY: Who's not being quiet?
 6 RENE: I'm being quiet. I didn't say a thing.
- WES: Well, I didn't say anything.AMY: Well, someone did.
- 9 RENE: Not me.
- 10 WES: Billy, who were you telling to be quiet?
- 11 BILLY: Relax, relax, it wasn't any of you.
- 12 WES: But who was it?
- 13 BILLY: Someone.
- 14 AMY: Does that someone have a name?
- 15 BILLY: Yes.
- 16 RENE: And is that someone at this table?
- 17 BILLY: Yes.
- 18 WES: Is that someone a girl?
- 19 BILLY: No.
- 20 WES: Then it's me!
- 21 BILLY: No, it's not you, Wes.
- 22 AMY: I know! He's talking to himself! (They ALL nod as if this
- 23 makes sense, and then go back to their reading.)
- 24 BILLY: (After a pause, he looks down) What's wrong? Are you
- 25 hungry?
- 26 WES: Who said they're hungry?

- RENE: I'm hungry, but I didn't say it out loud.
- AMY: I didn't say anything.
- WES: Billy?
- BILLY: What?
- WES: Who were you talking to?
- BILLY: Someone.
- AMY: I bet he was talking to his stomach!
- RENE: Oh, I do that! Mine starts growling in third period and I say, "Shut up, stomach." (They ALL nod, and then go back to their reading.)
- II BILLY: (After a pause) No, no, sit down!
- WES: What?
- II AMY: Who needs to sit down?
- II WES: No one is standing here, Billy.
- M RENE: Who are you talking to?
- WES: Maybe it's some mind game he's playing.
- II AMY: That's a weird game.
- RENE: Oh, I played that before. What you do is stare into someone's eyes and try to figure out what they're thinking. So Billy thought Wes wanted to stand up. Right, Billy?
- WES: You got that one wrong, Billy. I wasn't thinking about standing up, I was thinking about what I was reading and how I didn't understand it. But good try.
- AMY: Yeah, good try. (They ALL go back to their reading.)
 - BILLY: (After a pause) Yes, I love you, too!
- WES: Who?
- AMY: (Points to RENE.) Her?
- RENE: Not me! (Points to AMY.) Her? You love her?
- M AMY: Not me!
- M RENE: Well, it's not me!
- WES: Well, don't look at me!
- AMY: It could be you, Wes. Guys can love each other ... you know, like a brother.
- WES: Well, let me clue you in, Billy. (Points finger in his face.)

 Don't say that to me again! Unless I croak and you're

- trying to deal with your loss! (As if crying) "I miss you
- 2 man! You were my best friend! I love you, man!"
- 3 RENE: Wes, you are so stupid.
- 4 WES: Hey, wouldn't you girls cry if I suddenly bit the dust?
- 5 short pause as the girls look at each other)
- 6 RENE and AMY: No.
- 7 WES: Gee, thanks. (They ALL go back to their reading.)
- 8 BILLY: (After a pause, speaking baby talk) What is it? Huh? What
- 9 is it?
- 10 WES: (Pushes his chair back and looks on the floor.) What is iii
- 11 AMY: (Pushes chair back and looks on the floor.) I don't we
- 12 anything.
- 13 RENE: (Looks under the table.) I don't see anything either.
- 14 WES: Is it a bug?
- 15 AMY: (Moves away.) A bug?
- 16 RENE: (Moves away.) I hate bugs!
- 17 BILLY: It's nothing.
- 18 WES: Hey girls, it's nothing.
- 19 RENE: Thank goodness.
- 20 WES: He thought it was something, but it wasn't. (They Ald a
- 21 back to their reading.)
- 22 BILLY: (After a moment, he looks up.) Shhhh ...
- 23 WES: Shhhh? Who? Who's being loud?
- 24 AMY: I didn't say anything.
- 25 RENE: Neither did I.
- 26 WES: Then who are you telling to be quiet?
- 27 RENE: Well, this is a library, Wes.
- 28 WES: I know, Rene, but no one was talking.
- 29 AMY: Well, maybe he was thinking so loud that it sounded in
- 30 someone was talking.
- 31 RENE: I've done that.
- 32 AMY: So I guess he was telling himself to be quiet. (They all
- 33 nod and go back to their reading.)
- 34 BILLY: (After a moment, he looks down.) No, no, I can't play the

- ## ##ILLY: He is a friend, but actually...
- HENE: What?
- IIIIIIII: He's a dog.
- WES: (Looks under the table.) I don't see a dog.
- MAMY That's because he's imaginary, Wes!
- WENE: (Looking under the table) Ahhhh What color is he?
- HILLY: Black with white markings on his paws and ears.
- M AMY: Oh, how cute!
- WEST Billy, you're joking, right?
- HILLY: Hey, don't step on his paw!
- WESt (Jumps up.) I didn't step on his paw!
- M AMY: Wes!
- HENE: How could you do that?
- WEST I didn't? Did I? No, of course I didn't! How can I hurt someone who doesn't exist?
- ###### Yes, he does!
- WEST Then why can't I see him?
- MW Because you don't have an imaginary bone in your body!
- HENE: Is he OK, Billy?
- HILLY: (Looking down) He's OK.

- 1 WES: Hey, can your imaginary dog fetch?
- 2 BILLY: What?
- 3 WES: Can he fetch? (Tosses a pencil across the room.) Fetch, Fide
- 4 BILLY: His name is Bruno!
- 5 WES: Fetch, Bruno! (Pause as they stare at the pencil.) Guess not
- 6 AMY: Maybe he doesn't want to, Wes!
- 7 RENE: Yeah, and maybe he only takes orders from his master
- 8 Billy, can I pet him?
- 9 BILLY: Sure.
- 10 WES: (Laughs.) If you can find him!
- 11 RENE: He's right here. (Pets imaginary dog.) Isn't that right
- Billy? (Billy nods.) Oh, you're such a sweet dog!
- 13 AMY: Let me pet him, too! (Pets dog.) Oh, he is sweet!
- 14 WES: (Suddenly) Uh-oh!
- 15 AMY: What?
- 16 WES: My imaginary cat is hissing at your dog.
- 17 RENE: Wes, you don't have a cat!
- 18 WES: Sure I do. And I hope they don't get into a fight because
- my cat has these super sharp claws. See?
- 20 AMY: I don't see a cat.
- 21 RENE: I don't either.
- 22 BILLY: Me neither.
- 23 WES: You don't see my cat, but you see his dog?
- 24 AMY: Yes!
- 25 RENE: That's right, Wes. We don't see your cat.
- 26 WES: (Looking down, baby talk) It's all right, little kitty. I we
- 27 you.
- 28 AMY: Does your cat have a name?
- 29 WES: Yes, she does.
- 30 RENE: And that would be?
- 31 WES: Kiki.
- 32 RENE: Kiki?
- 33 WES: That's right. With huge, super sharp claws! (Hisses.) Did

- 35 AMY: What I heard was you, Wes.

- WES: No, no, that was my cat! Listen! (Covers his mouth and hisses again.)
- RENE: That was you, Wes.
- IIILLY: My dog's not afraid of your cat, Wes.
- WES: Well, he should be. 'Cause my cat is mean! (Hisses.)
- AMY: Oh, no!
- WES: What?
- AMY: I'm sorry, Wes!
- WES: For what? What?
- AMY: (Smiles.) My coyote just ate your cat. (As if petting her coyote) Were you hungry, Sweetheart?
- WES: Amy, you don't have a coyote!
- AMY: Yes, I do! And your cat ... well, I'm sorry.
- HENE: Want to know what I have?
- **MES: What? A stupid parakeet?**
- III RENE: (Proudly) I have a monkey!
- WES: A monkey?
- HENE: Yes, and I dress her up and carry her around with me everywhere.
- M AMY: Ahhhh ... What's her name, Rene?
- RENE: Mitzy.
- M AMY: That's a cute name.
- WES: (Points to RENE.) You don't have a monkey! (Points to AMY.) You don't have a coyote! (Points to BILLY.) And you don't have a dog!
- AMY: And you don't have a cat! Sorry. Nature can be cruel at times.
 - WES: Can we just lose this conversation over our imaginary pets and get back to our reading? Book report in one week, people!
 - RENE: Fine with me.
- AMY: Yeah, I need to finish this book. (They ALL go back to their reading.)
- BILLY: (Stands, speaking to his dog.) Stay.
- WES: Where are you going?
