1. Picture Day

CAST: (2M, 5F) MADISON, MR. DOBBS, JADE, LAURA, BECKY, MONA, PHILLIP PROPS: Chair, mirror.

1	(At rise MADISON rushes to the chair, sits down, and sinnes.)
2	MADISON: Ready!
3	MR. DOBBS: (Enters.) Great! Let's get started. First, if you would
4	turn just your shoulders to the siiiide. (Adjusts her
5	shoulders.) Yes, that's it. Chin down. (Moves her head
6	down.) And tilt your head like this. (Moves her head to the
7	side.) That's it. Now, sit up straight. (Steps back.) And hold
8	iiiit. (Moves back as he speaks.) Hold it, hold iiiit.
9	MADISON: (Moves out of the position.) Wait!
10	MR. DOBBS: What's wrong?
11	MADISON: What about my hair?
12	MR. DOBBS: Would you like to check the mirror?
13	MADISON: Yes, please.
14	MR. DOBBS: There's a mirror right over there.
15	MADISON: Thank you. (Looks into the mirror and arranges her
16	hair.) OK. I'm ready now.
17	MR. DOBBS: All right. Shoulders to the side. Chin down. Head
18	tilted. Just a bit more, please.
19	MADISON: You know I don't like tilting my head to the side
20	like this. It feels awkward.
21	MR. DOBBS: It helps to erase shadows. A bit more to the side,
22	please.
23	MADISON: (Moves her head.) Well, I don't want shadows.
24	MR. DOBBS: Yes, that's more natural.
25	MADISON: (With her head tilted awkwardly, she speaks in a stiff
26	tone.) Are you sure this looks natural?

- 1 MR. DOBBS: Sit up straight!
- 2 MADISON: I don't think I can sit up any straighter!
- 3 MR. DOBBS: (Claps his hands.) Come on, come on! Sit up tall
- 4 and straight! That will help reduce the appearance of your
- 5 double chin.
- 6 MADISON: I have a double chin?
- 7 MR. DOBBS: Pictures can be quite revealing. (Moves her hair.)
- 8 And one more adjustment right here. (Steps back.) Now
- 9 hold it ... (Quickly steps back as he is speaking) Hold it, hold
- 10 it ...
- 11 MADISON: (Moves out of the position.) Wait! Can we try
- something different? Like this? (Looking over her shoulder
- and smiling) Isn't this cute?
- 14 MR. DOBBS: (Frustrated) Miss ...?
- 15 MADISON: Riley.
- 16 MR. DOBBS: Miss Riley, this is a school picture, not an actor's
- 17 headshot! (Takes a deep breath.) All right, let's try this
- again. (Adjusts her.) Shoulders to the side ... Chin down ...
- 19 Head tilted ... Sit up straight ... And hold it ... hold it ...
- 20 (Quickly steps back) Smile!
- 21 MADISON: (Frowning) Wait! (Moves out of position.)
- 22 MR. DOBBS: What now?
- 23 MADISON: It feels all wrong!
- 24 MR. DOBBS: Well, it would help if you would smile!
- 25 MADISON: But every year my yearbook picture always turns
- out so bad! And this year I want it to be good! So can't I do
- something else? Maybe this? (Makes a dramatic pose and
- 28 smiles.) Or this? (Poses and smiles.)
- 29 MR. DOBBS: No, you may not.
- 30 MADISON: Or this? (Makes another dramatic pose.)
- 31 MR. DOBBS: (Begins to adjust her again.) Shoulders to the side \dots
- 32 MADISON: Wait! Can't I sit like this?
- 33 MR. DOBBS: No! To the side, please! Chin down ...
- 34 MADISON: But I don't like my chin down! And if I have a
- double chin, this isn't going to help!

- MR. DOBBS: Head tilted ...
- 2 MADISON: And tilting my head makes me look all spastic!
- 3 MR. DOBBS: And sit up straight.
- 4 MADISON: (Stiffly) I feel stupid!
- 5 MR. DOBBS: (Steps back.) Smile!
- MADISON: (Not moving, but glaring at him) What if I refuse to
- 7 smile? segretation that the for the spring passion
- 8 MR. DOBBS: Then, Miss Riley, you will look dumb in the school
- 9 yearbook. (Steps back.) Smile!
- 10 MADISON: (Moves out of position.) Wait!
- 11 MR. DOBBS: (Extremely frustrated) Miss Riley, do you realize
- how many pictures I have to take today?
- 13 MADISON: Hundreds?
- 14 MR. DOBBS: That's right! Hundreds! And I can't seem to get
- even one picture taken!
- 16 MADISON: I'm sorry, Mr. ...?
- 17 MR. DOBBS: Dobbs. Mr. Dobbs.
- 18 MADISON: I'm sorry, Mr. Dobbs, but this picture is a lifelong
- 19 memory for me! One day I'll be all old and wrinkled,
- sitting around with my grandchildren, showing them
- 21 pictures of how attractive their granny used to look, and ...
- 22 MR. DOBBS: Wow. You really think ahead, don't you?
- 23 MADISON: And Mr. Dobbs, I want my grandchildren to see me
- 24 for who I am!
- 25 MR. DOBBS: Which is?
- 26 MADISON: Dazzling! Unique! Gorgeous! I want my
- 27 grandchildren to scroll through the rows and rows of
- pictures and without hesitation be able to say, "Grandma,
- is that you? Why, you were the cutest girl in the whole
- 30 yearbook!" gasan an managan and a samu a
- **MR. DOBBS: So let's take a cute picture!**
- **MADISON: Thank you!** (Poses and smiles.) Ready!
- MR. DOBBS: (*Dryly*) Shoulders to the side. Chin down. Head tilted. Sit up straight. And smile.
- MADISON: (Frowning at him) But ...

- MR. DOBBS: Thank you. Next.
- MADISON: Wait! You took my picture like that?
- MR. DOBBS: Next! 3
- LAURA: (Enters) I guess I'm next. 4
- MADISON: Wait! Wait! I wasn't even smiling! 5
- MR. DOBBS: You had your chance, Miss Riley. If you would,
- please move out of the way and let this young lady sit
- down. What's your name, Sweetheart?
- LAURA: Laura.
- MADISON: But I was glaring at you! I wasn't smiling!
- MR. DOBBS: And I told you to smile, didn't I?
- LAURA: Why didn't you smile?
- MADISON: Because I wanted to take a cute picture!
- MR. DOBBS: And you had your chance. Now, if you would get
- 15 up and let this young lady sit down...
- MADISON: (Not moving) Had my chance? How could I have 16
- 17 taken a cute picture looking like this? (Demonstrates) My
- 18 body twisted to the side in an awkward position, my chin
- to the floor, my head flopped over like some spastic 19
- 20 person! And you want me to smile like this?
- MR. DOBBS: Miss Riley, will you please let the next person sit MR. DOBRS, wow You really thinkulturands from
- 22 down?
- 23 MADISON: No!
- 24 MR. DOBBS: No?
- 25 MADISON: Take it again!
- MR. DOBBS: Miss Riley, retakes will be taken after the first of 26
- 27 the year.
- 28 MADISON: After the first of the year?
- 29 MR. DOBBS: That's correct. So, if you don't like your picture ...
- 30 MADISON: This is just great! All my friends will be exchanging
- 31 pictures and I'll be stuffing them in my backpack! My
- 32 mom will be all excited to see them and then scream in
- 33 horror. Mr. Dobbs, please! Please!
- 34 MR. DOBBS: Do I need to send you to the principal's office?
- 35 MADISON: You can't send me to the principal's office! You're

- 1 just the picture guy!
- MR. DOBBS: I'll be right back. 2
- 3 MADISON: (Jumps up.) All right, all right, all right! I'm leaving!
- 4 Happy?
- MR. DOBBS: I don't think you want me to answer that.
- MADISON: (As she exits) I can't believe this! All I wanted to do 6
- was take a cute picture! 7
- MR. DOBBS: (To Laura) All right, if you would just take a seat.
- LAURA: (Sitting down) I don't really like having my picture taken.
- 10
- 11 MR. DOBBS: I understand. Now, if you would just turn your
- 12 shoulders to the side.
- 13 LAURA: Like this?
- 14 MR. DOBBS: Good. Chin down. And tilt your head to the side.
- That's it. And sit up as straight as you can. Good. And hold
- it ... hold it ... (Steps back.) Smile! (Returns) Good. Thank 16
- you. Next! (LAURA exits. JADE enters.) If you'll just have a 17
- seat right there. 18
- 19 JADE: I hate picture day!
- MR. DOBBS: I understand. Now, if you would just turn your
- shoulders to the side.
- 22 JADE: Whatever.
- 23 MR. DOBBS: Good. Chin down. And tilt your head to the side.
- 24 JADE: Can you like, hurry?
- 25 MR. DOBBS: That's good.
- 26 JADE: Do you want me to say cheese?
- MR. DOBBS: If you'd like.
- JADE: Cheese! 28
- 29 MR. DOBBS: Let's wait until I step back to take the picture.
- 30 JADE: Whatever.
- MR. DOBBS: Sit up straight. (Steps back.) And hold it, hold it ...
- 32 JADE: Do you want me to say cheese now?
- MR. DOBBS: Smile!
- 34 JADE: I thought I was going to say cheese!
- 35 MR. DOBBS: (Frustrated, he approaches her.) Do you want to say

- 1 cheese or smile?
- 2 JADE: Well, I thought I was supposed to say cheese!
- 3 MR. DOBBS: Then say cheese!
- 4 JADE: Cheese!
- 5 MR. DOBBS: But don't say cheese until I take the picture!
- 6 JADE: OK, fine!
- 7 MR. DOBBS: (Steps back.) Say cheese!
- 8 JADE: Do you want me to say cheese and then smile or just say
- 9 cheese?
- 10 MR. DOBBS: Smile!
- 11 JADE: Or did you want me to smile and then say cheese?
- 12 MR. DOBBS: (Screams.) Say cheese and smile!
- 13 JADE: Cheese! (Gives a big smile, then stands and exits.)
- 14 MR. DOBBS: Next! (Moves about shaking his head and wiping his
- 15 forehead.)
- 16 BECKY: (Enters.) You want me to sit down?
- 17 MR. DOBBS: Please.
- 18 BECKY: I think taking pictures is stupid!
- 19 MR. DOBBS: If you would turn your shoulders to the side,
- 20 please.
- 21 BECKY: (Turns.) It's just a way for you guys to make money.
- 22 Send us home with these dumb looking pictures that our
- parents feel guilty about not buying.
- 24 MR. DOBBS: Chin down.
- 25 BECKY: My mom always buys the entire package even when
- they're bad. And they're always bad.
- 27 MR. DOBBS: Tilt your head to the side, please.
- 28 BECKY: Sends pictures to my grandparents, aunts, uncles,
- cousins ... And you know, I really wish she wouldn't. Like,
- 30 yuck!
- 31 MR. DOBBS: And sit up straight.
- 32 BECKY: And the only good thing about picture day ...
- 33 MR. DOBBS: Smile!
- 34 BECKY: Is getting out of class. (Smiles.)
- 35 MR. DOBBS: Next!

- BECKY: And you know, maybe I'll take my sweet time walking
- 2 back to math class. You know, smell the roses. Stop in the
- 3 bathroom. Stop by my locker. Take an early lunch ...
- 4 MR. DOBBS: Thank you. You may leave now. (BECKY exits.)
- 5 Next!
- 6 MONA: (Enters. Enthusiastically) Hi!
- 7 MR. DOBBS: Hi. If you would please take a seat.
- 8 MONA: Oh, sure! Thank you! I bet you love your job, don't you?
- 9 MR. DOBBS: Yeah, sure.
- 10 MONA: I mean, you get to meet so many people every day! And
- make people smile all the time! I bet it's the best job in the
- world!
- 13 MR. DOBBS: If you would, turn your shoulders to the side.
- 14 MONA: Absolutely! I just love having my picture taken!
- 15 MR. DOBBS: Chin down.
- 16 MONA: Chin is down!
- 17 MR. DOBBS: And tilt your head to the side just a bit.
- 18 MONA: How's this?
- 19 MR. DOBBS: That's fine. And sit up straight.
- 20 MONA: Straight as a board!
- 21 MR. DOBBS: (Steps back.) Smile.
- 22 MONA: (Gives a huge smile.) Oh, I just love having my picture
- taken! Hey, do you want to take it one more time in case I
- 24 blinked?
- 25 MR. DOBBS: Retakes are after the first of the year.
- 26 MONA: Oh, OK! Well, thank you! Thank you so much! (Shaking
- 27 his hand) And it was such a pleasure to meet you! I guess
- I'll see you next year! That is, unless I have to come back
- for retakes. But I don't think I will. I think they will be OK.
- OK, well I better go so you can get back to work! Have a
- great day! And I know you will because you have a great job! Bye! (Exits.)
- 33 MR. DOBBS: Next! (MADISON rushes in and sits down.) Oh. no!
- Not you again!
- 35 MADISON: Shoulders to the side. Chin down. Head tilted. Sit

- 1 up straight. (She smiles.)
- 2 MR. DOBBS: Retakes are after the first of the year.
- 3 MADISON: (Still smiling) Just pretend I'm someone else, OK?
- 4 MR. DOBBS: That's not possible.
- 5 MADISON: (Smiling) Or pretend I'm not here. Either way.
- 6 MR. DOBBS: We already took your picture.
- 7 MADISON: (Smiling) One more time, OK?
- 8 MR. DOBBS: Look, this is supposed to go quick! (Snaps.)
- 9 Students sit down, I give instructions, they smile, I snap
- and they leave! And after four hundred or so pictures,
- then I get to go home! (Looks at his watch.) And the way
- this is going today, I'll have to come back tomorrow! And
- the only time that has happened to me was in 1998 when
- an unexpected fire drill sent kids marching out of the
- school. And believe me, I don't like coming back for a
- second day!
- 17 MADISON: (Smiling) I'll be quick. As soon as you take my
- picture, I'm out of here!
- 19 MR. DOBBS: Next!
- 20 MADISON: (Smiling) Just take it real quick, OK?
- 21 MR. DOBBS: Next!
- 22 MADISON: (Smiling) It'll be our secret, OK? I slipped in and you
- didn't notice that you took my picture twice.
- 24 MR. DOBBS: Oh, I noticed! Believe me, I noticed!
- 25 MADISON: I'm smiling! I'm ready!
- 26 MR. DOBBS: Next!
- 27 PHILLIP: (Enters.) I'm next.
- 28 MR. DOBBS: Good. If you would please take a seat.
- 29 PHILLIP: I would, but (Motioning to MADISON)
- 30 MR. DOBBS: Miss Riley!
- 31 MADISON: (To PHILLIP) Just give us a minute, OK?
- 32 MR. DOBBS: Sir, if you would sit down.
- 33 PHILLIP: I would, but ...
- 34 MADISON: (Smiling) One quick picture and I'm out of here!
- 35 PHILLIP: Could you please hurry up? I have to get back to gym.

- 1 Coach is going over some critical plays for the game on
- Friday.
- 3 MADISON: (Smiling) I'm ready!
- 4 MR. DOBBS: (Takes a deep breath, then steps back.) Smile!
- 5 MADISON: I'm smiling!
- 6 MR. DOBBS: And there we go. Thank you. You may leave now.
- 7 MADISON: But you didn't take my picture! The flash didn't
- 8 even go off!
- 9 MR. DOBBS: Well, what do you know? Sorry about that. Retakes
- are after the first of the year.
- 11 MADISON: But I want my retake now!
- 12 MR. DOBBS: What you want and what you get are two different
- things, Missy!
- 14 MADISON: Oh my gosh! How hard is it to take a stupid picture?
- 15 MR. DOBBS: Obviously not very hard because that's exactly
- what we took of you!
- 17 MADISON: What?
- 18 PHILLIP: Uh ... can we do mine now?
- 19 MADISON: No!
- 20 MR. DOBBS: Yes! Sit down!
- 21 PHILLIP: I would, but ...
- 22 MADISON: And I'm not budging until you take my picture
- again! And not another fake one, Mr. Dobbs! A real
- picture! (Smiles.) I'm smiling! I'm ready!
- 25 PHILLIP: Should I come back?
- 26 MADISON: Yes!
- 27 MR. DOBBS: No!
- 28 PHILLIP: Yes? No?
- 29 MR. DOBBS: Please, take a seat!
- 30 PHILLIP: I would, but ...
- 31 MADISON: I'm not budging, Mr. Dobbs! Shoulders to the side,
- 32 chin down, head tilted and sitting up straight! Ready!
- 33 PHILLIP: I'll come back.
- 34 MR. DOBBS: Don't you dare leave!
- 35 MADISON: Don't worry. I'm not.

0	another picture of you! Then another and another and
1	another if that's what it takes! You will look like the rest of
2	your classmates!

4	classmates! I want to look cute! (MADISON and MR. DOBBS
5	exit as PHILLIP is left standing there. After a moment, he sits
6	down in the chair, looks around, and then smiles.)
