- would you cancel your party so that I can have mine?
- 13 ASHLEY: Um ... Didn't you say you were almost in high school?
- Barbies? Really? How about a day at the mall instead?
- 15 Deal?
- 16 TINA: Deal.
- 17 ASHLEY: Great. Now I'd better go break the news to a few
- people ... (Starts to walk off.)
- 19 TINA: How many did you invite?
- 20 ASHLEY: Oh, just one or two ...

The Party

CHARACTERS

(3 Girls, 2 Guys)

Ashley: Younger sister of Tina; has been threatened to leave Tina and her friends alone.

Tina: Hostess of the party. Wants her sister to stay far away from the basement.

Daniel: Funny guy. Loves to cut up.

Gregory: Loves food. Can be a little dense.

Tori: Friend who shows up late with the food. Very bubbly and happy.

SETTING

Tina's house.

- 1 ASHLEY: (Walking into the room with DANIEL. TINA and GREGORY
- 2 are already On-Stage.) Geez, he's your guest. Couldn't you
- 3 even get the door?
- 4 TINA: (Ignoring ASHLEY. To DANIEL) You're only thirty minutes
- 5 late. Come on in!
- GREGORY: I told you to get Daniel here on time you would have
 to tell him it starts an hour earlier.
- 8 DANIEL: Sorry! My mom made me clean my room before I came.
- 9 I am so ready for high school. Surely she'll back off a little
- 10 then and treat me like an adult.
- 11 TINA: Good luck with that. My mom freaks if I leave a dirty sock
- on the floor. I doubt me being in high school is going to
- 13 change that.
- 14 GREGORY: Not my mom. With working two jobs, she doesn't
- have time to care what my room looks like. It's awesome.
- 16 DANIEL: No. It's disgusting. Even for me! The last time I was
- 17 there, I found molded bologna under your bed and I'm
- pretty sure I saw cat puke on a plate that was on your
- 19 dresser.
- 20 GREGORY: Cat puke? I don't even own a cat!
- 21 DANIEL: Well you had some kind of nasty brown junk growing
- on that thing then.
- 23 GREGORY: Brown junk? Dude! Those were refried beans.
- 24 (Pause) I forgot all about them! I wonder if they're still good.
- 25 ASHLEY: You are one seriously sick person.
- 26 TINA: (Now realizing ASHLEY hadn't left) I thought you were
- 27 staying upstairs?!
- 28 ASHLEY: Chill. I'm just getting a movie. I told you I wouldn't
- 29 interrupt your party, didn't I?
- 30 TINA: Just hurry, please.
- 31 DANIEL: (To TINA) I thought you said she wasn't going to be
- 32 here?
- 33 TINA: (Obviously annoyed) Mom's idea.
- 34 ASHLEY: Mom said in order for you all to come over, after
- Daniel's streaking incident last time (Looks at DANIEL), I

- had to be here with my friends for you all to be left alone.
- I was instructed to check in every hour and text Mom with
- 3 a detailed report.

- DANIEL: You're kidding! Just for semi-streaking? I was in my boxers. I've seen bathing suits worse than that!
- GREGORY: I'm just mad I missed getting it on my phone.
- 7 TINA: Not me! It's bad enough that memory is burned into my brain forever. I may need some serious therapy in years to
- 10 DANIEL: May need? Is that really a question for you, Tina?
- 11 ASHLEY: Anyway, I'm not going to rat you guys out. Just
- please don't do anything stupid so I won't get in trouble for not checking in on you.
- 14 TINA: Good. So go upstairs to your stupid little friends and
- leave us alone.
- 16 DANIEL: Yeah. This basement is for eighth graders only.
- 17 Preschoolers should stay upstairs. Isn't it time for your
 - milk and cookies?
- 19 ASHLEY: Very funny. I should write that down, it's so funny.
- 20 GREGORY: (Was playing with his phone and not paying attention)
 - Did somebody say cookies? (Gets up to go get some.)
- 22 TINA: (Grabs his arm.) There aren't any cookies.
- 33 GREGORY: What?! Why would somebody say cookies if there
- aren't any cookies?! What kind of party doesn't have
- 25 cookies?

- 26 TINA: Chill. Tori's bringing chips and cookies.
- 27 ASHLEY: (With sarcasm) Unless you'd like to join us preschoolers upstairs.
- 20 TINA: (Grabs ASHLEY's arm and pulls her to a doorway.) You got
- your movie, now get out of here.
- ASHLEY: Geez. So much for being nice, huh? It's not my fault
 Mom doesn't trust you.
- 11 TINA: Whatever. Just get out. You are ruining my party!
- Sometimes you are so annoying, I just can't stand the
- sight of you. (ASHLEY leaves. Everyone looks a little

- uncomfortable about the outburst until DANIEL speaks after a 2 few beats.)
- DANIEL: So where's the rest of the gang?
- TINA: Well, Bella and Joy can't come. So of course that means 4
- 5 Michael can't.
- DANIEL: Yeah, that dude is seriously whipped.
- GREGORY: Where's the cookies ... I mean, where's Tori?
- TINA: Don't worry. She'll be here soon. While we're waiting. 8
- 9 check out these old pictures I found. I put them in a
- 10 **PowerPoint**. (Holds up remote like turning on a projector.)
- 11 DANIEL: Always the overachiever.
- 12 GREGORY: Yeah, no wonder everyone always wants you on their
- 13 project team. (ALL act like they are looking at pictures on a
- 14 screen.)
- 15 DANIEL: Oh my gosh, look at that picture! Where on earth did
- 16 you get that? I thought I burnt every last one!
- 17 TINA: That's the beauty of camera phones.
- 18 GREGORY: Nice hair, dude.
- 19 DANIEL: Aw. The Mohawk days. Hard to believe I thought I was
- 20 cool with that thing.
- 21 TINA: I can't believe your mom let you get it. She doesn't seem
- like the my-kid-has-a-Mohawk kind of mom. 22
- 23 DANIEL: She isn't. My dad was. He didn't really have a choice
- though. See, I found this awesome picture of him with a 24
- mullet -25
- 26 GREGORY: No way! Business up front; party in the back! I can't
- believe your dad had one of those. 27
- 28 DANIEL: Yeah, and a Harley. With that kind of ammo, he had to
- say yes. I think he was just glad that I wasn't pushing for 29
- 30 a tattoo.
- 31 TINA: (Staring at the picture) Bet now you wish he hadn't given in
- so easily. Those are some serious spikes! 32
- 33 TORI: (Enters and looks at picture.) Oh my gosh, Daniel! You're

- 35 DANIEL: That was the point! I was the shortest guy in my class.

- GREGORY: (Grabbing for the bag she brought) What took so long? 4

- 8 The last time you guys were here, my mom took money out

- 12 GREGORY: (Shoving food in his mouth) Growing boys need food.
- Ask anyone.
- 14 TORI: So what'd I miss?
- 15 DANIEL: (Pointing back at picture) Not one thing, unfortunately.
- 16 TORI: I really did like your hair that way. No other sixth grader 17
- in school had one.
- 18 DANIEL: I know. The principal tried to make my parents get it
- cut. And that's when my mom got all "attorney" on him. 19
- She didn't even want me to have it, but when she thought 20
- 21 they were violating my rights — or rather her parental

- 6 TORI: Yeah, but look at you. I think you were supposed to paint
- the walls, not your body!
- 8 TINA: (Mimes clicking again.) And here's one from 4-H camp.
- DANIEL: Wow. Were we *young*. It's hard to believe that was justa few years ago.
- 11 TORI: (To TINA) Remember how you were in love with the
- 12 archery instructor?
- 13 TINA: How can I forget? My mom still has the letters I wrote
- from that week saying how I was going to marry him! The
- funny thing is, I don't even think he knew my name.
- 16 GREGORY: He was way more interested in the hot college girls
- 17 that were helping out around camp.
- 18 TINA: Don't remind me. I must've looked so stupid to him. I
- 19 even left him love notes.
- 20 TORI: Oh! And then on the last day when you jumped up and
- 21 kissed his cheek I thought I would die! You should've
- seen his face. He probably told all his friends about the
- 23 stalker girl he met at camp.
- 24 TINA: (Clicking) Well, we've seen enough of that. Here's one of
- 25 Gregory from our first middle school dance.
- 26 TORI: (Pointing and laughing) What on earth are you wearing,
- 27 Gregory?
- 28 DANIEL: Dude, were you trying to be John Travolta from
- 29 Saturday Night Fever?
- 30 TORI: (Can hardly contain laughter.) Oh my gosh! That is the best
- 31 picture I have ever seen in my entire life.
- 32 TINA: He even popped his collar! And slicked back his hair a
- 33 little.
- 34 GREGORY: Someone told me it was a theme dance.
- 35 TORI: And you believed them?

- GREGORY: Obviously. Why else would I look like that?
- 2 DANIEL: I don't know. I think you were just trying to get the
- girls, man.
- 4 GREGORY: Well, believe me, I didn't. The only chick that danced with me was uh, forget it.
- TINA: No, you can't lead us on like that and then not tell us.
- 7 GREGORY: Hey, you were there. If you didn't see it, then too bad.
- TORI: Wait ... wait ... I think I remember oh yeah! I didn't see it, but everyone was talking about it the next day.
- 11 DANIEL: So what's the big deal, who's the mystery lady?
- 12 (GREGORY tries to cover up TORI's mouth. They struggle and
- 13 eventually TORI yells out.)
- 14 TORI: Mrs. Trimble!
- 15 TINA: You danced with Mrs. Trimble?!
- 16 DANIEL: The librarian?!
- 17 TORI: Now why don't we have a picture of that?!
- 18 GREGORY: It's not like I had a choice! The old lady grabbed my
- hand and drug me out there. What was I going to do?
- 20 Knock her down?
- 21 DANIEL: Aw, come on. Admit it. You liked it.
- 22 TORI: Mrs. Trimble the original Cougar! That's priceless.
- 23 GREGORY: I never thought I'd live that down. I can't believe you guys don't remember that.
- 25 TINA: Well, we didn't really know you that well then. We just weren't in the right spot at the right time.
- TORI: Knowing us, we were in the bathroom trying to figure out how to get Mike Spencer to pay attention to us.
- 29 TINA: Us? I think you mean me.
- 30 TORI: Let's get real here. He wasn't noticing either one of us,
- but if he had noticed me, I would've left you in the dust.
- 32 TINA: Wow. And here I thought you were my friend!
- 33 TORI: I am. Best friend. But we both know, back then, we
- would've picked Mike Spencer over anybody!
- 35 TINA: I would never pick a guy over you, Tori. (DANIEL "rawrs"

2	GREGORY: Cat fight.

The Room

CHARACTERS

(2 Girls, 1 Guy)

Tina: Girl who regrets the things she's done when she finds herself in a room filled with reminders of her life.

Tori: Tries to comfort Tina and make sense of their lives. The first to realize what has happened to them.

Chad: Daniel's older brother who picked them up to take them to the school dance. He was the one driving the car that wrecks and brings them here to "The Room."

SETTING

A very stark room filled with note cards (can use real props or mime looking at cards).
