The Poker Game

Cast: Brandon, David, Shane, Adam Setting: A poker game at David's house Props: Tray with assorted food and drinks, poker chips and deck of cards

- 1 BRANDON: David, you got anything to drink?
- 2 DAVID: Yeah ...
- 3 SHANE: Food?
- 4 DAVID: Yeah ... gimme a second ...
- 5 ADAM: You knew we were coming here, why isn't the food
- 6 ready?
- 7 BRANDON: What's poker without food?
- 8 DAVID: (Entering with tray of food and drinks) It would be
- 9 poker at your house, loser.
- 10 BRANDON: I resent that!
- 11 ADAM: No, you resemble that ...
- 12 SHANE: You never have food at your house.
- 13 BRANDON: I can't help it. And, Shane, you never even have
- 14 the game at your house.
- 15 SHANE: My parents don't approve of gambling under their
- 16 roof.
- 17 DAVID: But it's OK under someone else's roof?
- 18 SHANE: Go figure. Adam, toss me one of those Cokes.
- 19 ADAM: Diet or regular?
- 20 SHANE: Look at me, buddy. Note the toned arms and flat
- abs. The diet. Regular!! Please, you insult me.
- 22 DAVID: So, Brandon, deal.
- 23 BRANDON: Ante up, my friends. Texas Hold 'em, nothing
- wild except us! (He deals and the game continues

throughout the rest of the scene unless someone folds and moves away from the table.)

ADAM: Yeah, we're a wild group. Friday night, poker with the boys, sandwiches prepared by David's mom, who is in the other room and sodas. Whoooohoooo, watch out for us!

SHANE: Where's Natasha tonight, Adam?

ADAM: Church.

DAVID: Repenting for the sins of going out with you?

M ADAM: She's a good girl.

II BRANDON: So, why's she going out with you?

II ADAM: I'm a catch, buddy! I got it all.

II DAVID: They have medication for that now.

ADAM: You're a riot, David. Maybe that's why you don't have a girlfriend.

DAVID: Don't want one. (Referring to his hand) I'm all in.

SHANE: I got nothing. (Tosses his cards in, moves away from table.)

ADAM: Why don't you want one? (To his hand) I'll call.

BRANDON: I got nothing. (Flips cards to continue game.)

DAVID: I'm too busy.

2 SHANE: With what?

13 DAVID: School, ASB, baseball, ya know.

BRANDON: And you can't fit a woman in all that?

25 DAVID: Could, but don't want to.

26 BRANDON: This is the river card.

27 ADAM: Gimme what I need, baby.

28 DAVID: (The card is flipped.) And there it is! (He scoops up

29 the pot.)

30 SHANE: What's he got?

31 ADAM: He gets a two on the river. Oh my God! I have a pair

of aces and this guy wins with two in the hold and a flip

33 of a three.

34 SHANE: You are so freakin' lucky.

35 DAVID: Skill my friend, skill.

- 1 BRANDON: Everyone in?
- 2 ALL: Yeah, sure, I got some money left. (Etc.)
- 3 BRANDON: Ante up, losers. (He deals, the game continued)
- 4 OK, I know why I don't have a girlfriend. I can be kind
- 5 of a jerk.
- 6 ALL: (Filled with sarcasm) No, not really. Come on. You
- 7 Never!
- 8 BRANDON: It's been known to happen. And Shane here, he
- 9 has plenty of women.
- 10 SHANE: This is true. Women love me. It's a burden I bear
- 11 ADAM: I have a girlfriend.
- 12 SHANE: Which is proof that there is a merciful God who
- takes pity on the scum ...
- 14 ADAM: Say what you will, Natasha will be calling me when
- she's done with her church thing and then tomorrow
- we go out.
- 17 DAVID: And that's the answer.
- 18 ADAM: What?
- 19 DAVID: Your life is planned. She calls after church, you go
- out on Saturday, blah blah blah.
- 21 SHANE: I don't do that.
- 22 DAVID: No, you're even worse. You go out with a bunch of
- different girls, and you have to either lie to them or tell
- 24 them the truth, then they get all hurt. Too much
- 25 trouble.
- 26 BRANDON: I'd like that kind of trouble.
- 27 DAVID: And you, Brandon, you're the worst. Flip the next
- 28 card, buddy.
- 29 BRANDON: Sorry. Who's in?
- 30 SHANE: Check.
- 31 ADAM: Raise three.
- 32 BRANDON: Too rich for me (He starts to fold, then
- 33 reconsiders.) Ah, go for it. Why am I the worst?
- 34 DAVID: Call. 'Cause you want a girl so bad you make a fool
- of yourself in front of them. It's embarrassing.

- | SHANE: True that.
- ADAM: Yeah.
- BRANDON: (Shrugging) Yeah, well, waddahya gonna do?
- 1 DAVID: So, I do the smartest thing.
- ADAM: Which is?
- DAVID: Let the ladies come to me. Last card, please.
- 7 SHANE: Man! Now he flips a queen.
- ADAM: Nothing!
- DAVID: Straight. (He tosses BRANDON a chip.) A little
- something for the dealer.
- 11 SHANE: The ladies come to me.
- 12 DAVID: They come to you, Shane, because they think they
- might end up in a "relationship."
- 14 SHANE: They might.
- 15 BRANDON: Right. You couldn't stay with one girl longer
- than a month if your life depended on it.
- 17 SHANE: Yes, I could.
- 18 ADAM: When? When have you ever been with one girl
- longer than it took between haircuts?
- 20 SHANE: Whatever.
- 21 ADAM: While I, on the other hand, have the security of a
- woman who loves me and cares about me ...
- 23 DAVID: And plans every minute of your life.
- 24 ADAM: She does not.
- 25 DAVID: You going to that dance next month?
- 26 ADAM: Of course.
- 27 DAVID: (Mimicking him) Of course. (Normal voice) I'm in.
- 28 BRANDON: Me, too.
- 29 SHANE: Raise five.
- **30 ADAM: Five? You never raise more than two.**
- 31 SHANE: (He smiles.) You in or out?
- 32 ADAM: Out.
- 33 DAVID and BRANDON: Call. (The game continues.)
- 34 ADAM: So, I'm going to the dance, so what? Of course I'd be
- 35 going.

- 1 DAVID: Shane, you?
- 2 SHANE: Yeah. Don't know with who yet, though. Shirley in
- 3 Jen.
- 4 DAVID: Have you told either one yet?
- 5 SHANE: Nah. The dance is three weeks away. No rush.
- 6 DAVID: So, they're both waiting on you? Both have probable
- already turned down other guys hoping you'll ask
- 8 them.
- 9 BRANDON: Is that why Kate turned me down? She's
- waiting for Shane to ask her?
- 11 ADAM: Yeah, Brandon. You tell yourself that.
- 12 DAVID: You know something? I've gone to every dance
- since my sophomore year. Every one.
- 14 ADAM: Big deal. So have I.
- 15 DAVID: With Natasha.
- 16 SHANE: Well, I've gone, too.
- 17 DAVID: With drama around every one. (Mimicking
- distraught girls) Oh, Shane said he'd take me. No me. No
- me! Shane!!! What's going on? Boo hoo hoo.
- 20 ADAM: Remember when Britney and Paige got into that
- 21 fight in the quad and then you turned around and
- 22 asked Debbie?
- 23 SHANE: They both got suspended and couldn't go to the
- 24 dance anyway. Saved me some trouble. I wanted to ask
- Debbie in the first place.
- 26 BRANDON: Why didn't you just tell them?
- 27 SHANE: That would have hurt their feelings.
- 28 DAVID: And getting in a fight and getting suspended was
- 29 better?
- 30 SHANE: At least I didn't look bad.
- 31 DAVID: You're a sensitive guy, Shane. A real role model.
- 32 BRANDON: I've gone to dances.
- 33 DAVID: To every dance? Since your sophomore year?
- 34 BRANDON: Well, this year. I'm a late bloomer.
- 35 SHANE: OK, you live in that world, Brandon.

- DAVID: My point being, (He looks at the cards and smiles.) I win again.
- ADAM, SHANE and BRANDON: I don't believe this! You are so lucky. I hate this game.
- ADAM: So, what's your point?
- DAVID: I've never asked a girl to a dance. They always ask me. I'm a nice guy, people like me, I get along with everyone and the girls know that we will be going "as friends." Which, may I add, is financially wise as well.

 The girl asks, she pays half. It's all good.
- II SHANE: The girl pays? I'm liking that.
- 11 ADAM: I always have to pay.
- DAVID: That's because you're a couple. Deadly. And costly.
- BRANDON: OK, but why don't the girls ask me?
- DAVID: Because you reek of desperation. It hangs on you like the stench from a freshly fertilized field.
- 17 ADAM: Nice alliteration.

- 10 ADAM: Very nice.
- 10 DAVID: "A" in English last semester.
- II BRANDON: Hello! You were saying.
- **III** DAVID: Women are very much like poker.
- **BRANDON:** I'm listening.
- M SHANE: Maybe you should be taking notes.
- **BRANDON:** Shut up, Shane.
- 16 SHANE: Merely a suggestion.
- 17 ADAM: I'd take notes if I were you.
- DAVID: OK. It's this way. The reason why you never win at poker and you never win with the ladies is because you are always chasing them.
- BRANDON: Women want to be chased.
- SHANE: Chased, maybe. Stalked? Whole different thing.
- DAVID: Seriously. No matter what cards you are holding, you stay in the game. Even if there's no chance of you winning the hand.

- ADAM: That is so the way you are, Brandon! You never with at poker and you never win with women.
- DAVID: You gotta know when to hold them and know when to fold them. (He throws more chips on the table
- 5 Brandon matches his bet, the rest fold.)
 6 SHANE: Yeah! Like asking Kate to the dance. So out of your
- league. But then there's Mindy. She'd be all over going with you.
- 9 BRANDON: But she's not hot.
- 10 DAVID: Yeah, she is. OK, maybe she's not Kate hot, but she's
- cute. And really nice. (The river card is turned.) She's not
- a royal flush, but she's a winning hand. Very much like
- this pair of tens with the ace high. Sorry guys. (1)
- smiles happily and cleans up another pot while the guy react loudly and with annoyance.)
- 16 BRANDON: I had tens!
- 17 DAVID: But no ace high. That's a real shame, buddy. Amil
- that's what I mean. You go after something you have m
- way of getting.
- 20 BRANDON: But we both had tens. Both of us!
- 21 DAVID: But did you have the ace? No, my young friend, you
- did not. And that's where we differ. Mindy is your account and you're folding
- and you're folding.
- 24 SHANE: Very good analogy, David.
- 25 ADAM: You deserved that "A," for sure.
- 26 BRANDON: So I should ask Mindy.
- 27 DAVID: If you want to go to the dance.
- 28 BRANDON: (Getting up) I'm out. Adam, you deal this one.
- 29 I'm calling Mindy and locking this in now.
- 30 SHANE: Excellent move, Brandon, excellent. (BRANDON exits.)
- 32 ADAM: You set him up, didn't you? She's going to turn him down.
- 34 DAVID: That would be funny, wouldn't it? But, no. However,
- I did ask her if she'd go with him. She said she would.

- She already has her dress, so what the heck, right?
- SHANE: So, we're all going to the dance?
- ADAM: Like I have a choice.
- DAVID: Who are you taking?
- SHANE: I don't know, but I know I'm going. I'll figure it out later.
- ADAM: David, what about you?
- DAVID: Yeah, probably. Leanne said that Jessica was going to ask me, so whatever.
- BRANDON: (Entering) I have a date! She said yes.
- 11 DAVID: Excellent work.
- 12 ADAM: I'm proud of you, man!
- III SHANE: Now deal.

- BRANDON: OK, I can feel my luck turning. Ante up and prepare to lose all your money. (He deals quickly.)
- DAVID: (Looking at cards) I fold.
- 17 ADAM: (Looking at cards) Me, too.
- III SHANE: (Looking at cards) I'm out.
- III BRANDON: I won! Did you see that? I won! (The others shake
- their heads and shrug their shoulders at his joy.) Hey, I'll
 - take what I can get. (He smiles and gathers his chips.)
