The Room

CHARACTERS

(2 Girls, 1 Guy)

Tina: Girl who regrets the things she's done when she finds herself in a room filled with reminders of her life.

Tori: Tries to comfort Tina and make sense of their lives. The first to realize what has happened to them.

Chad: Daniel's older brother who picked them up to take them to the school dance. He was the one driving the car that wrecks and brings them here to "The Room."

SETTING

A very stark room filled with note cards (can use real props or mime looking at cards).

- (The stage can be dark, or the actors can act as though the stage
 is dark.)
- 3 TINA: Daniel, Tori, Gregory! Where are you?
- 4 TORI: (Pause and then say faintly) Tina, is that you?
- 5 TINA: Tori? Where are you? I can't see you! Can you hear me?
- 6 (The lights can come up and they rush and hug each other
- 7 frantically. Or they stumble around, bump into each other, and
- 8 then hug frantically. They don't pull apart from the hug until9 after the next few lines.)
- 10 TORI: Oh my gosh! I was so scared! I thought I'd lost you! I
- can't find Gregory, or Daniel. Or even Chad! Where are
- 12 they?
- 13 TINA: I don't know. It was so dark. I couldn't see anything!
- 14 (When they pull apart, they see the blood on their shirts. They
- 15 look around terrified.)
- 16 TORI: Tina, are you OK? Where did all this blood come from?
- 17 TINA: I don't know! What's going on? (CHAD comes rushing in
- He's covered in blood too and very panicked about finding his
- 19 brother.)
- 20 CHAD: (Near hysteria) Where's Daniel? Have you seen him? I
- 21 can't find Daniel.
- 22 TINA: I don't know. We haven't seen him. Or Gregory either
- Only us.
- 24 CHAD: What's happened to them?
- 25 TORI: (Pauses and looks around.) What's happened to us?
- 26 TINA: I don't know. I think ... there was ... an accident ... there
- 27 was a truck.
- 28 TORI: (Puts face in hands.) Oh my gosh. I remember it now
- 29 There was a horrible crashing sound and then tiny pieces
- 30 of glass were flying around everywhere!
- 31 CHAD: Oh no. This is all my fault! I was driving. I didn't even
- 32 see a truck. I just remember something slamming into the
- 33 side of my car.
- 34 TINA: Headlights were coming at us really fast.
- 35 TORI: Yeah, the guy didn't even brake. He totally flew through

- the stoplight. I bet he was drunk or something.
- CHAD: I still should have seen him. I should have done something.
- TINA: It wasn't your fault, Chad. It was like he came out of nowhere.
- 6 CHAD: That won't matter to my dad! Or my mom! They're
 7 always preaching to me about my driving. Telling me to go
 8 slow through intersections ... always look both ways even
