   Saturday! In two days. Can you believe it? I'm so excited.
- I can't stand it! I won't even sleep on Friday night.

- 13 BECCAH: Geez. Can you *be* a little more excited for me?! This is only the biggest, best, most amazing thing that's ever
- 15 happened to me. You don't even seem to care.
- 16 KELSEY: I do care. It's just not that big of a deal. I mean, you17 go to the movies all the time. And you've had an older
- boyfriend before. Wasn't Thomas in eighth grade?
- 19 BECCAH: Eighth grade? You can't even compare this to that.

- 5 BECCAH: Who knows? Wouldn't that be awesome? The two of us dating high school guys!
- 7 KELSEY: Just make sure the friend is hot too. Even half as hot as Andrew would be OK.
- 9 BECCAH: Tell me about it. Now I just have to worry about how 10 to look good standing next to him. That's the downfall of 11 dating someone completely gorgeous!
- 12 KELSEY: Are you kidding me? You will make *him* look bad. And that's saying a lot.
- BECCAH: Thanks, you're the greatest friend to say that, even though we *both* know it's not true!
- 16 KELSEY: Well, you may not make him look bad, but I think you two will make a great couple. Like Ken and Barbie.
- 18 BECCAH: (Sighs.) I know. I can just picture it now. He's going 19 to be so nice to me, so cute, and so mature! He'll be the 20 most perfect date I've ever had. That anyone in the history
- of dates has ever had!

- 22 KELSEY: He'll probably open all the doors for you, buy your 23 ticket, and do everything for you. Oh, like when the guy
