CAST: (2M, 3F) ZACH, MADISON, CARLY, REBECCA, JOHN SETTING: School cafeteria. PROPS: Table, two chairs, tissues.

1	(At rise MADISON is sitting at a table in the cafeteria. A sim-
2	taped to the table reads: 'Free Advice'. ZACH enters.)
3	ZACH: What's this? Free advice?
4	MADISON: That's right. May I help you?
5	ZACH: (Looks around the room.) Uh this is the cafeteria.

- MADISON: I know.
 ZACH: (As if she doesn't know) Where you eat lunch.
- 8 MADISON: And have the opportunity to speak to a counselor at
- 9 the same time.
- 10 ZACH: Do the teachers know you're doing this?
- 11 MADISON: Mrs. Harris and Mrs. Rodriguez have both walked
- 12 by and smiled at me so I guess it's OK.
- 13 ZACH: And you're doing this for free?
- 14 MADISON: You read the sign. Free advice.
- 15 ZACH: OK, Miss Smarty Pants, I'll try out your free advice.
- 16 MADISON: (Sits up straight.) All right. How may I help you?
- 17 ZACH: Well, I can't decide. Do I eat the Salisbury steak or the18 chicken nuggets?
- 19 MADISON: That's not the type of advice I give.
- 20 ZACH: Why not?
- 21 MADISON: My advice is on more important issues.
- 22 ZACH: Such as?
- 23 MADISON: Such as boyfriend or girlfriend problems. Issuer at
- home. Dealing with the death of a loved one.
- 25 ZACH: So you can give me advice for dealing with my peta
- death, but not figuring out what to eat?

- MADISON: My advice ... listen to your instincts.
- ZACH: My instincts, huh? Well, half of my instincts are saying the Salisbury steak is gross and other half of my instincts is saying the chicken nuggets are a sorry excuse for feeding a growing teen. So you tell me, Miss Free Advice Person, what am I to do?
- MADISON: Go with the Salisbury steak.
- ZACH: The Salisbury steak? Why?
- MADISON: It looks good.
- ZACH: But I hate the Salisbury steak!
- MADISON: Then go with the chicken nuggets.
- ZACH: The chicken nuggets? Have you ever tried their chicken nuggets? They taste like rock nuggets!
- MADISON: Then dip them in ketchup.
- ZACH: But who wants to eat a rock hard chicken nugget smothered in ketchup?
- MADISON: (Jumps up.) Then don't eat! Just don't eat! There! That's my advice!
- ZACH: Gee, thanks a lot! That really helped. See if I come back to you for free advice again! (Exits.) (MADISON takes a deep breath and sits down. CARLY enters, rushing to the table in a panic.)
- CARLY: I need some advice! I mean, I really, really, really need some advice!
- MADISON: Absolutely. Why don't you take a seat and we can talk.
- CARLY: OK. (Sits down.) So here's my problem. How do I get Katlyn and Samantha to stop spreading rumors about me?
- MADISON: Well, first I suggest that you confront Katlyn and Samantha ... in a very nice way of course, and ...
- CARLY: (Slams her hand on the table.) Oh, I confronted them all right! But it wasn't in a nice way!
- MADISON: Then why don't you try it again, and this time ...

- 17 MADISON: You are! And you wouldn't take her back if she

- 19 JOEY: Yes, I would!
- 20 MADISON: No, you wouldn't!
- 21 JOEY: OK. No, I wouldn't.
- 22 MADISON: It's a blessing in disguise.
- 23 JOEY: It is?
- 24 MADISON: It is! The tears are gone! The girl is gone! And you

- 26 JOEY: (After a pause, he grabs a Kleenex.) You know what?
- 27 MADISON: What?
- 28 JOEY: Your advice stinks! And you know what else?!
- 29 MADISON: What?
- 30 JOEY: I'm going over to Katy's table right now and I'm going in
- 31 let her know how I feel!
- 32 MADISON: You'll be sorry.
- 33 JOEY: (Pulls the poster off the table which reads "Free Advlow")
- 34 And you need to change this!
- 35 MADISON: To what?

JOEY: Lousy Advice! (Exiting) Katy! Katy! Can't we work this out? Please take me back!

MADISON: (Stands.) I don't give lousy advice! (Replaces poster.) I think my advice is good!
